BASIC DAILY FEE

The basic daily fee is used to cover the day-to-day expenses such as meals, laundry and cleaning.

ACCOMMODATION COSTS

Each residential aged care home has different accommodation costs and your loved one may be asked to contribute to their accommodation costs.

You can fund the accommodation amount as a refundable lump sum, referred to as a refundable accommodation deposit (RAD), or in periodic payments, referred to as a daily accommodation payment (DAP), or a combination of both.
